Description: Chi Wan has a clean-shaven head, save for a long, braided topknot. Chi Wan always assumes a calm, pleasant demeanor, even when under duress. Wears the traditional brown Jedi robes. He is very easily underestimated, as he has a demure, almost submissive and humble bearing to him.

History: Not much is known about the Jedi Master Chi Wan Su, save that he was the last Padawan of Jedi Master Mace Windu shortly before the Clone Wars. Chi Wan served the Old Republic admirably during those years, and earned himself a reputation as perhaps one of the best, if not *the* best Jedi when it came to overcoming his opponents without the use of his lightsaber.

In the years the Empire rose to power under Palpatine, when Darth Vader hunted down and destroyed the Jedi, Chi Wan disappeared. There is a fragmented story about a violent encounter between the two, but if such a story is indeed true, then Chi Wan was at least strong enough to prevent Vader from destroying him, or resourceful enough to escape.

Chi Wan has lived out a solitary existence amongst the nature worshipping Dranu on the remote Outer Rim world of Bantoon. He maintains a small farm and a simple home, and he has been all but forgotten by the universe at large. Chi Wan has contacted Luke Skywalker in recent months through the Force, and the two have met in person to discuss the future of the Jedi. The aging Jedi Master has never had a pupil before, at least none that he has ever mentioned, and it remains to be seen if Chi Wan will either offer to help Skywalker. In the meantime, Chi Wan has informed the New Republic that he would be willing to help gauge the potentials of those strong in the Force, and to determine if these beings should indeed be trained in the ways of the Jedi.

One of the disagreements Chi Wan has with Skywalker is whether or not those beings with the potential to use the Force should be accepted into training even after they have aged far beyond the years of early childhood. The old Jedi tradition was to only accept students who were very young, perhaps even infants. Although there are very few Jedi in the galaxy now, to simply gather up all those who could learn how to control the Force

and hope for the best would be foolish, for nearly all of these would-be students are too set in their arrogant or ignorant ways to truly approach the Force with an unfettered mind. Yes, the Jedi are needed to restore peace and justice to the galaxy, but to rush the process and overlook the Jedi tradition of seeking out very young initiates would prove just as disastrous as the Jedi Council approving of Anakin Skywalker's training against their own initial judgments. Where Skywalker feels that older students are needed to quickly fill the absence of Jedi, Chi Wan is instead seeking out new children of the Force throughout the galaxy.
